

- 5. <u>Financial Director</u>—in charge of fundraising which includes 50/50 tickets, coordinates Kick Off Party door prizes, Thank You letters to ad and door prize sponsors.
- 6. Newsletter Editor gathers information at monthly Executive Board meetings, then organizes information and prepares the monthly newsletter, sends info to our web site.
- 7. <u>Communications Director</u> in charge of all promotional work and publicity by media for Kick Off Party, membership drives, fundraising, etc., and responsible for monthly web Calendar Page.
- 8. <u>Trustees</u> (4 elected) attend the Executive Board meetings to offer opinions, learn the operation of the club, responsible for end of year audit of treasurer's records.

The term runs from May 2025—May 2026. The Board meets once a month to plan and organize events. Officers are all expected to lead at least one event and assist with other events.
